Delegant was asked to organise and manage a global phase III clinical trial investigator meeting in Zurich. The meeting was augmented with a kick-off meeting and CRA training prior to the main meeting.

The meeting required us to work directly with both the sponsor company (biotech) and their contract research organisation (CRO) as well as five other companies who were providing services for the clinical trial. These included IVRS, central laboratory, rater trainers, product manufacture and product supply as well as working with independent oversight committees. In total 150 people attended from 12 different countries including Australia, US, Israel, and India.
